<p>E Safety The children will have access to the internet and other ICT facilities at school. The school takes every reasonable step to prevent the children from accessing inappropriate materials through the use of a filtering system. The children will be expected to follow our e-safety rules. The school can check the children's computer files and monitor their use of the internet.</p>		
<p>Photography Photographs and video may be taken of children at school as part of the curriculum, on line assessments, in school events such as music performances or sporting activities, or to promote the school on the website, in the media or school documents. Names will not published next to images.</p>		
<p>Educational visits The children will engage in learning outside the classroom as part of the curriculum. This could involve leaving the school grounds to visit other places in the locality, under the supervision of school staff. This may be a short walk along the footpaths around the school, or a visit to a local church or park. These visits will always take place during normal school hours. You will receive information about these activities before they take place.</p>		
<p>Emergency Medical Treatment In the case of an emergency when at school or off site, school staff will administer first aid and contact the emergency services.</p>
