
Easter Raffle

Safety around the school

Some of you may be aware that a child from the junior school was knocked off their bike on the way to school yesterday.

An incident such as this obviously heightens our concerns about safety around the school. Although the accident was not caused by poorly parked cars we all know that the way a minority of parents park and drive heightens the risk of accidents. Please keep away from the school entrances and do not park where there are double yellow lines.

We have also had reports of a male adult talking to the children in the area around the school. We heard about these incidents via facebook rumours and would ask parents to raise any concerns directly with us so we can act promptly. Once we knew of the situation we immediately contacted the police who have responded by adding patrols around the schools.

This situation acts as a useful reminder to the families whose children arrive too early for school. The gates do not open until 8:40 am when staff are on duty. Children who arrive before this time are spending time on a crowded pavement unsupervised.

We have also had complaints from local residents re parents using private carparks and drive ways. Please park considerately.

Sickness Bugs

Please remember children should be kept off school for 48hrs from the last time they were sick.

As the school was closed due to the weather conditions on World book day, we have decided to re-arrange it for **Wednesday 28th March**.

We would love to see lots of children dressed as book characters, but if your child doesn't want to then they should come to school in normal school uniform.


