Bring a teddy and some lunch and enjoy a picnic and play with us.

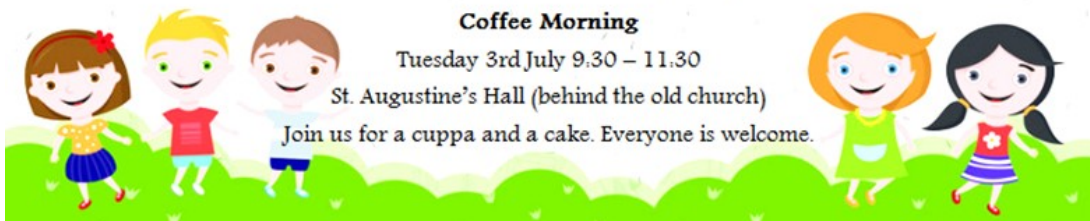
