Staffing reductions

As you are aware, we are currently in the process of implementing staffing reductions across the two schools. This is a difficult time, no more so than for our colleagues who are directly affected. Out of respect to staff it is important that we follow an agreed and confidential process. This means that we can only provide limited information at this stage.

As previously communicated, we will be able to share a staff structure for mums, dads and carers after half term. This will show how we will teach and support the children within a tighter budget.

The most significant changes will be the mixed age class for Reception and Year 1 children and increases in class sizes at the Junior School from approximately 20 in a class to approximately 28. This will be in line with similar schools. The loss of some support staff will mean we will have to change the way we support learning outside the classrooms. This is our main concern but is happening in most other schools due to the rising staffing costs and reduced budgets that all schools are having to contend with this year.

Mums, dads and carers are encouraged to contact the school to ask any questions and raise any concerns.

Congratulations to Miss McIntosh who has been appointed to a new post in a new school. Miss McIntosh will be leaving us at the end of the summer term to take up this exciting venture. We are sure you will join us in wishing Miss McIntosh all the best for the future and thanking her for all the hard work she has put into her time at Angel Road

If you bring a bike or scooter to school and leave it in the cycle sheds please remember to bring a sturdy lock.

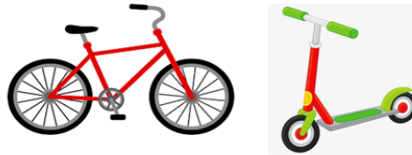
