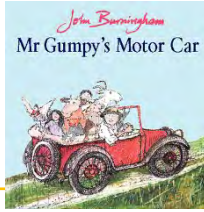


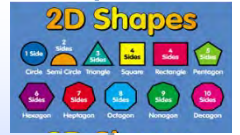
Wow starter to topic:

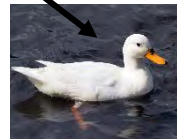
