## Procedures for notifying families of a positive case of Covid 19.

If we have confirmation of a positive case that affects school, we will send a text and then a follow up email to the children, classes or year group that needs to isolate. We will then send a 'There has been a positive case in School' letter to all parents across the school – this does not specify which year group has the positive case to protect confidentiality.

## Christmas Cards – a very COVID Christmas at Angel Road

This year, children can still bring Christmas cards in for their friends if they would like to. However, it is important that we put in place some controls to help prevent the spread of infection:

- ◆ Christmas cards can only be brought in on either **Monday 7th, Tuesday 8th or Monday 14th December**;
- ◆ They must be put into a collection box which will be left outside the classrooms;
- ◆ Cards will be quarantined for 72 hours and handed out in the afternoons of **Friday 11th and Thursday 17th December**.

Please explain to your child that they **cannot just hand out cards to their friends for safety reasons and they must put them in the box** on either a Monday or a Tuesday.

## FSM vouchers over the Christmas holidays

If your child currently receives Free School Meals (FSM), we will be providing you with a £15 a week food voucher from Edenred. This has been funded by Norfolk County Council's Winter package. If you currently receive FSM's, it is essential that we have your **correct email address**.

If you think you may be eligible for FSM – please contact the school office and we will send you a form to complete.

## Christmas at the Junior School

We will be creating a Christmas atmosphere within school in an adapted way. Year 4 usually put on our Christmas performance of The Grinch; they will be creating a video to share with parents of them reading the poem. Other year groups will be having Christmas crafts afternoons and we will be decorating our windows so that the school looks festive from the outside.

### Remote Learning - Seesaw

In the event of a class or year group having to self-isolate, the learning will transfer to Seesaw online. It is the expectation of the DfE and the school that all children take part in their learning and we will be contacting you if we notice that your child hasn't been engaging in their lessons to discuss how we can support you. Teachers will teach the full timetable and this will include a daily reading, writing, maths lesson – your child's class teacher will video a 'good morning class video' on Seesaw to go through the lessons coming up that day and lessons will start at 9.00am.

Thank you for the amazingly positive feedback from parents and children who have already experienced remote learning.
